

You will need:

- Level
- Tape Measure
- Pencil
- Drill/Electric Screwdriver
- Appropriate hardware and anchors for your wall type
- Masking Tape

Installation:

Map out glass board placement on wall

- 1 Apply masking tape to wall where the top of the tape is 3/8" above the desired top of the glass board. Use a level to ensure masking tape is level to space. Important: the top edge of the masking tape will serve as your reference for measuring when installing the wall clips. The final top of the glass board will be 3/8" below the top of the tape.
- 2 Measure the width of top of the glass board. Using this length measurement mark the desired locations of the two vertical edges of the board on the wall.

Wall clip placement

- 3 Measure from the top of the glass board to the bottom of first z-clip to find wall clip placement height. Then measure the length of the z-clip to find it's width.
- 4 On the wall, measure from the top of the masking tape to mark the wall clip's distance from the top of the glass.
- 5 Measure in 6" from desired vertical edge of glass board on the wall to mark the length of the wall clip. Draw a line level to the space to mark the overall horizontal placement of wall clip.
- 6 Repeat for each z-clip, measuring from the top of the glass board and masking tape each time.

Install Wall Clips

- 7 Place wall clip on the wall with corrugated side facing the wall and cleat pointing up.
- 8 Align top of wall clips with marks on the wall, then mark screw holes.
- 9 Remove wall clips from the wall. Drill and place anchors as needed.
- 10 Attach wall clips with hardware appropriate to your wall type.

Verify Alignment and Spacing

- 11 Check to ensure each wall clip is level to space.
- 12 Verify dimensions between clips and overall placement of glass board.

Installing Glass Board Onto the Wall

- 13 13. Using at least two people carefully lift glass board. Careful! The glass maybe heavy!
- 14 14. Place glass board against the wall 2"-3" above desired location, then lower slowly till z-clips interlock.
- 15 15. Clean glass and enjoy.

Care and Cleaning

Use only glass cleaner on your glass board. Avoid multi-surface products, a dedicated glass cleaner works best. Do not use abrasive or scouring cleaning products.
